### **3. Care Network/IDS (slides 2-6)**

- Lisa Williams opened, discussed mission statement and purpose of IDS – the working arm of the Community Action Information Board (CAIB).
- IDS consists of representatives from all Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst Community support agencies. This is a “purple” organization which supports all members of all military branches represented and their families.

### **4. JB MDL Resiliency Strategy Progress (slides 7 & 8)**

- For 2014, Resilience Pathways’ status is at 5,376.
- Frontline Supervisor Training is at 92% for required personnel. All E5/6s trained is at 88%.
- 16 MRTs trained.

### **5. IDS Initiatives & Community Action Plan Outcomes (slide 9)**

- Resilience training goals are g2g.
- Both Resilience Pathways and JB MDL Resilience website goals are ongoing.

### **6. CAP Initiatives & CAF Funding (slides 10-16)**

- All key initiatives discussed.
- Support and encouragement for attendance in resilience initiatives is red (CAIB/IDS Action).
- Updates to CAP slides: Single service members newcomer’s orientation in March. Focus on junior enlisted and no bus tour.
- Transition for Life: Committee to measure then vs. now.
- CAF Funding- designated funds for initiatives total 115.7k.

### **7. Suicide Prevention Checklist (Slides 17-19)**

- Suicide Prevention Checklist reviewed.
- Track feedback more efficiently among all wings.

### **8. Suicide Prevention/ Mental Health (slides 22-32)**

- On track to be lower but no pattern.
- Early help seeking campaign was briefed by Capt Hasbrouck.
- Spike in 2012.

### **9. Substance Abuse/DDRDP (slides 35-37)**

- Domestic referrals trending down.
- Increase in duty referrals.
- Decrease in positive urinalysis and DWI.

### **10. Sexual Assault and Prevention Response Program (slides 39-40)**

- Burlington County College crisis agency is providing media literacy training.
- Team teal performed for 87 ABW and 621 CRW Comprehensive Fitness Day.

### **11. Family Advocacy Program (slide 42)**

- Decrease from last year.
- Trends are the same across the services.
- Victim Advocate has been working with SFS and indicated she has been getting more calls from them to brief.

### **12. Military and Family Support Center**

- Staff is working to make the slide more relevant to IDS/CAIB because in tracking trending the stats remained steady, generally.
- Readiness is trending up.
- Challenges- how do you share this on a slide: CRCs meet with commander and are attached to units. Twice weekly the 621 CRW has office hours for their CRC.
- EFMP pumpkin picking had twice the participation this year over last
- Dare to Dream was a success: first time partnerships and 80+ attendees. Project 360 partnered to help.

- Slide shows unit visitations for CY14.

- Requirements have changed.
- Uptake on sexual harassment complaints.

### **15. Army**

- 14 Skills for resilience are covered over the course of the year.

### **17. Air Force**

- Seeing different battle rhythms among the wings.

### **18. Navy**

- Forming a cultural diversity group.

### **19. Alibis**

- Working on obtaining two medicine drops on the installation.
- FAP is offering a “stressless holiday” class.
- Main gate at Lakehurst will be closed.
