## OEM Training Courses

### Office of Emergency Management Training Courses

The Joint Base Office of Emergency Management (OEM) offers a wide variety of courses to personnel across the installation. The valuable courses offered by OEM vary from the basic, instruction on Sheltering in Place (SIP), to more complex tasks such as training personnel to be members of the Emergency Operations Center (EOC). Below is a list of just some of the courses offered and brief course description.

**Emergency Operations Center (EOC) Course-** The EOC is a command, control and communication element. Primarily focused to recover JB MDL from any situation which degrades mission capability, it is a focal point for resources and functional expertise. The EOC coordinates on scene operations and support requirements with the Joint Base and provides liaison with off-base civil authorities and response elements. Each agency representative directs and coordinates the activities of their respective organizational elements and functional support with their control center. These elements are referred to as Emergency Support Functions (ESF) who coordinate with their civilian local, county and state counterparts to advise and support the Incident Commander. This course will teach you to become an effective member of the EOC and well as teach you the common terminology used inside the EOC.

**Emergency Preparedness Liaison (EPL) Course-** Unit EPL representatives manage their unit's Emergency Management (EM) program and participate in base disaster planning and recovery programs. They are responsible for assessing the unit EM program and keeping the unit commander and personnel updated on EM related topics. This course will teach you how to start and maintain an efficient EM program.

**Control Center Operations (CCO) Course-** The CCO provides a focal point within the organization to monitor unit resources and mission capability and to coordinate their activities during disaster operations. This course teaches how to properly staff and operate a control center should you be assigned as a member of your unit's control center.

**Shelter In-Place (SIP) and Evacuation-** This training will ensure personnel understand the principles and execution requirements if directed to SIP/ Evacuate. Using an all-hazards threat approach, personnel will be instructed on how to SIP for their own protection and given details on evacuation protocols.


