

Air Show Rules

All carry-in items and persons are subject to search

Prohibited items

Weapons of any kind including:

- Pocket knives
- Pocket tools
- Scissors
- Box cutters
- Nun chucks
- Batons
- Large, heavy chain-link jewelry or belts
- Mace and pepper spray
- Firearms of any type
- Drones
- Laser pointers

Other prohibited items include:

- Toys that resemble firearms
- Fireworks
- Spray paint and Silly String
- Glass containers of any kind
- Alcohol
- Illegal drugs
- Bicycles, Scooters
- Skateboards
- Heelies, Roller skates, or Rollerblades
- Coolers
- Balloons
- Ruc sacks, backpacks (Except clear/mesh bags)
- No pets (except service dogs)

Permitted items

- Strollers and wagons for toddlers
- Diaper bags
- Lawn chairs
- Women's purses
- Handicapped items such as wheelchairs
- Cameras, video recorders, and binoculars, mono / tripods

Recommended items

- Comfortable shoes
- Lawn chairs
- Ear plugs
- Sunscreen
- Cameras
- Diaper bags
- Pen for autographs
- Water bottles

Safety items

- Smoking is allowed in designated smoking areas ONLY! Smoking is NOT allowed anywhere in the show area.

Aircraft safety

- Do not touch or climb on any aircraft unless you are invited to do so by the aircrew.
- Remember that trash can be sucked up into aircraft engines, damaging the aircraft and endangering the pilot's life. Please keep the flightline litter-free by using the trash receptacles provided for your convenience.
- Trip hazards are everywhere. Watch for tent ropes and aircraft tie-down chains.
- Observe all signs, including the ones that say "do not touch".

First aid

- Drink plenty of fluids.
- Apply sunscreen. Temperatures on the flightline typically are higher than normal. Bring a hat to protect the top of your head.
- Take time out to rest during the day.
- A first aid tent will be set up. Look for the red cross.

Lost and found

- A lost and found/information booth will be set up to report lost children. Announcements will be made over the public address system. Bring found items or report lost items to the lost and found/information tent.
